Citizens to Serve on Gloucester Board of Equalization

Gloucester County is seeking interested citizens to serve on the Gloucester County Board of Equalization. The board serves as an appeal board for the county's real estate assessment. The duties of the board are to hear taxpayers' concerns for correction of their real estate assessments, and increase, decrease or affirm such assessments.

The Board of Equalization consists of five (5) members who upon recommendation by the Board of Supervisors are appointed by the Circuit Court. Each member shall be a resident of the county and a majority of the members must own land in the county. There is one upcoming vacancy on the Board of Equalization for a three-year term to begin January 1, 2018. Preference will be given to the following professionals: business owner, attorney, or commercial/residential real estate appraiser.

Those interested in serving on the Board of Equalization for Gloucester County are asked to complete a Volunteer Board Bank interest form on the county's website at www.gloucesterva.info and under "Quick Links" and select "Boards and Commissions."
