Spring Residential Household Harmful Waste Collection for Gloucester

Gloucester County's Spring 2017 Household Harmful Waste Collection Day will be held Saturday, April 15, 2017 from 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM at the Main Landfill Convenience Center located at 3714 Waste Management Way. Rene' Moring, Gloucester's Clean Community Coordinator states, "The Household Harmful Waste Collection program is the best way for Gloucester County residents to rid their homes of hazardous items in a way that is safe for their family, community, and the environment."

The spring collection of household harmful waste allows residents an opportunity to dispose of automobile hazardous waste such as antifreeze, brake and transmission fluids, gasoline (and mixtures thereof), and automotive and other lead-acid storage batteries. Used motor oil can be routinely recycled at any of the County's Convenience Centers. Residents can also safely dispose of painting supplies including paints, thinners, solvents, epoxies, wood preservatives; gardening, yard, and household chemicals such as pesticides and herbicides, toxic and caustic household cleaners, mercury, pool chemicals; and main computers and monitors.

Items not accepted at the special collection include: ammunition, explosives, fireworks, and marine and other flares; radioactive waste; asbestos; drugs, medicines, and other medical waste. Certain electronics including television sets, computer keyboards, and printers can be taken to the Convenience Centers at any time.

Keep Gloucester Clean and Green

The Household Harmful Waste Collection is open only to residents of Gloucester County. The next Household Harmful Waste Collection is October 21, 2017 at Hayes Convenience Center, located at 7599 Guinea Road.
