Activities will include encampment, troop formations and roll call by authentically costumed re-enactors; drilling of the volunteers; and musket firing demonstrations. Cannon firing will take place on the 1st Presbyterian lawn across from the Courthouse Green. The public is encouraged to participate and all those recruited for service will receive a certificate.

At 3:30 a wreath laying ceremony will be held at the monument in the Court Circle in honor of the members of the 7th Virginia Regiment and all veterans who have served their country.

At 6:00 pm the public is invited to attend a celebration featuring a fiddler and traditional dance taking place upstairs at the Gloucester Museum of History across from the Courthouse Circle
