Gloucester Launches New Broadband Information Hub

Gloucester County has launched a new “one-stop shop” for citizens to obtain information on broadband availability and connectivity news in the locality. The hub can easily be accessed through a link on the County’s website (www.gloucesterva.info). The site details Gloucester’s strides to leverage all opportunities - allocation, grants, outside funding, partnerships, and regional collaboration - to provide broadband access to everyone in the community.

The hub is a step toward fulfilling one of the Gloucester County Board of Supervisors’ strategic priorities, which is to provide all residents of Gloucester County options for access to unrestricted, fast, and reliable broadband service.

A highlight of the new hub is an easy-to-understand, quick overview of the “who, what, where, and how” of connectivity in Gloucester. It is a PowerPoint presentation with a voiceover by Gloucester’s Deputy County Administrator Carol Steele, who has been instrumental in the County making strides toward broadband accessibility for all citizens.

“We are excited to bring this new informational hub to our citizens,” Steele said. “We receive many inquiries about broadband availability in the County on a daily basis, and we hope the information provided on this site will help answer most of those questions.”

The broadband hub has been a joint effort among County Administration, its GIS Department, and its Community Engagement & Public Information Department.
