Gloucester Real Estate and Personal Property Bills Mailed

The Gloucester Treasurer's Office mailed out the first installment 2022 real estate and personal property tax bills May 31. Bills are due Thursday, June 30.

The Gloucester County Board of Supervisors voted in April to reduce the tax rate for cars, trucks, motorcycles, and a few categories of trailers, as allowed by State Code. "So, even though vehicle values are higher across the board than they were last year, the reduced tax rate brought the actual tax bill closer to last year's amount," said Gloucester Treasurer Tara Thomas.

Thomas pointed out there is an issue on certain bills with travel trailers that qualify for the reduced tax rate, which was not identified until after the bills were mailed. "While the item is listed, the tax amount is missing on the bill, so it appears that the total is incorrect," Thomas said. "The total due showing on the bill is correct even though some of the item amounts are missing."

If you have not received your tax bill(s) or you think your bill is incorrect, please contact the Treasurer's Office at 804-693-2141 to verify what you owe. By law, failure to receive a bill does not relieve the taxpayer of penalty and interest that will accrue for failure to pay by the due date. Accounts remaining unpaid after the due date are subject to additional charges as provided by the Code of Virginia and the Gloucester County Code.

Payments can be made via the following methods:

- Online by credit card (2.5% fee) or E-check (free): Visit www.gloucesterva.info/332/Payment-Options. Be sure to have your bill handy so you have all the information needed.

- By phone (Official Payments): Call 1-800-272-9829 and use Jurisdiction Code 1087 (3% fee). You will provide the information from your bill to complete the payment.
- Drop Box: Place your check/money order and payment stub(s) to the Treasurer's Office at 6489 Main Street, Gloucester, VA 23061. Be sure your payment envelope is postmarked by the Post Office on or before the due date.
- In office: Pay by check, cash, money order, or credit card in the Treasurer's Office at 6489 Main Street, Gloucester, VA 23061.
