- A legible sketch plan, drawn to scale, depicting the proposed location the activities – including, but not limited to, merchandise, parking, circulation, pedestrian and vehicular ingress/egress, surface materials, and sanitary facilities, if any.
If you are applying for a permit for a Farmers' Market, the following also apply:
 1. No temporary or seasonal permit shall be issued unless adequate provision is made for off-street parking and safe ingress and egress to the adjacent street; VDOT review and approval may be required.
 2. No overnight storage of vehicles shall be permitted, and no permanent structures associated with the site's use as a farmers' market shall be placed or erected on the site.
 3. Hours of operation shall be limited to daylight hours.
- Written and signed authorization from any property owner upon whose property the proposed activities are to take place, confirming that the applicant has the right to use such property for the entire duration listed on the application.
- Proof of applicable Health Department approvals if the proposed activity requires the same, or a letter from the Health Department stating that none are required.
- Indicate the type of signage proposed for this use. **See permitted signage on page 2.**

A separate zoning permit may be required prior to installation of any signage and a building permit may also be required depending on the proposed sign(s). Any signage other than exempted signage defined below shall be permitted in accordance with Article 12 of the Zoning Ordinance.

Definitions:

Farmers' market: A seasonal gathering of vendors in a predetermined, centralized location for the display of hand-made or regionally harvested agricultural, horticultural, silvicultural, and/or seafood products, excluding livestock, produced off-site and brought to the market for sale; the occasional sales of pumpkins, Christmas trees, and other annual products shall also be permitted

Seasonal sales: The sales of goods and products - such as pumpkins and Christmas trees - that are associated with a particular season or holiday and sold on a temporary and/or annually recurring basis.

Sec 12-8. Exempt Signs (h.)

Temporary agricultural signs. Temporary signs pertaining to an agritourism activity and/or the related retail, farmer's markets, farm produce stands, wayside stands, roadside stands, and wayside markets. Such signs shall not exceed twenty (20) square feet each, and shall not remain in place for more than thirty-one (31) days. The aggregate square footage total of all signs pertaining to activity or sales shall not exceed one hundred (100) square feet per activity, business, or parcel
